

7th Sunday after Pentecost**GOSPEL**

Continuation of the holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, 7. 15-21.

IN ILLO TÉMPORE: Dixit
Jesus discíplis suis: Atténdite a
falsis prophétis, qui véniunt ad
vos in vestiméntis óvium,
intrínsecus autem sunt lupi
rapáces: a frúctibus eórum
cognoscétis eos. Numquid
cólligunt de spinis uvas, aut de
tríbulis ficus? Sic omnis arbor



bona fructus bonos facit: mala autem arbor malos fructus facit. Non potest arbor bona malos fructus fácere: neque arbor mala bonos fructus facere. Omnis arbor, quæ non facit fructum bonum, excidétur et in ignem mittétur. Igitur ex frúctibus eórum cognoscétis eos. Non omnis qui dicit mihi, Dómine, Dómine, intrábit in regnum coelórum: sed qui facit voluntátem Patris mei, qui in coelis est, ipse intrábit in regnum coelórum.

AT THAT TIME, Jesus said to his disciples: Beware of false prophets, who come to you in the clothing of sheep, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. By their fruits you shall know them. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit, and the evil tree bringeth forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can an evil tree bring forth good fruit. Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit, shall be cut down, and shall be cast into the fire. Wherefore by their fruits you shall know them. Not every one that saith to Me: Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of heaven: but he that doeth the will of My Father who is in heaven, he shall enter into the Kingdom of heaven.
