Importance of the Devotion:

Second, every time we say it we receive the most copious graces and benedictions. Third, we drive the devil from our sides. Fourth, we protect ourselves from all kinds of evils. Each time we say Jesus' name, we make an act of love so perfect and a prayer so powerful that God cannot resist it. As Our Lord Himself told the apostles, "Whatsoever you shall ask of the Father in My name, you shall receive." What a promise! God cannot deceive us or give us a promise which He does not fulfill. Let us then make an effort to say with reverence and devotion, the Holy Name of Jesus.
