**The recent scandals in the Novus Ordo clergy** is the logical spiritual fruit of the revolution of the Vatican II church. The destruction of the Faith and Morals among the clergy reflect the failure of Prayer (Faith) and Penance-Discipline (Morals). Where one fails to keep an eye toward the Father by Faith, the danger of infidelity to the graces of the Holy Ghost results. The very character of the post Vatican II era was a mockery of Doctrine and Piety (doing for the love of the Father). Effectively the entire discipline of the Church has been under attack resulting in moral turpitude in the clergy, both priest and Bishops and higher, as well as lay folks. The Catholic Church is composed of saints and sinners but the Novus Ordo religion is one of false Faith and Morals, false Prayer and Penance.
