Precepts of the Church

To help to provide for the needs of the Church according to one's abilities and station in life

Commentary: While the Church has the innate right to require from the faithful whatever is necessary to support its legitimate temporal activities, in fact it rarely exercises this authority, Do not muzzle the ox that treads the grain, means the Church and her laborers deserve their care. The Precept leaves to individual Catholics the right to determine precisely when and how they will assist with the temporal needs of the Church. The obvious lack of specificity, however, should not be taken as a sign that they may be, for all practical purposes, ignored. Sunday collections, annual appeals, spontaneous offerings, bequests and wills, and so on are all ways that Catholics have to satisfy this precept of support. Note that offerings given for a specific purpose can be used by Church authorities only for that purpose. Mass request do not partake of fulfilling the precept.
