EXPLANATION OF EPIPHANY:

Christmas is the intimate family feast of the Catholic Church. Epiphany is the world feast of the Catholic Church. At Christmas, God appears as man. At Epiphany, this man—Christ—appears to the world as God. Christmas is the feast of God's manifestation of Himself as man. Epiphany is the manifestation of His Divinity. The fact that Christ was man needed no demonstration; He had only to be born and live among us. The fact that this helpless child was God needed proof and demonstration. Christ's birth would mean nothing to us unless He were also God. So, the feast of His humanity must be completed by the feast of His divinity.
