EXPLANATION OF EPIPHANY:

This feast presents not so much an event in Christ's childhood as it expresses the manifestation of the Son of God to the world and the shining forth in all its splendor of the Incarnation. Epiphany means "manifestation". Epiphany stresses two important ideas which have special meaning in our time. First, it stresses the Manifestation of Christ as the Son of God. Secondly, it emphasizes the extension of Christ's Kingship over the whole world.
