### WHY THE PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

Why does the Church have Precepts? To recognize a Catholic in Good Standing the Church has her precepts. If one has a profession, (one’s practice in life), all expect that this person can fulfill minimums in that field. A roofer must know how to put roofing up, at least one kind of roofing, correctly. He might then have a recognized standing in that field. It is how we know someone has a minimum practice of the Faith.

For instance, to receive Communion properly in the Easter season, about a 97 day interval, is one of six criteria by which we may know if someone is a Catholic in Good Standing. So, when a politician, or ditch digger says they are Catholic, this is a good thing, but when they establish they are a “Catholic in good standing” well, that means something! So, say a representative in Congress is a Catholic, that is good, but are they in Good Standing? Have they received the Holy Eucharist properly?

We cannot say that they have received the Holy Eucharist properly if they do not confess properly, this includes amending their life. They may have weaknesses but there must be amendment amidst their weaknesses: the firm purpose to change bad habits. Even if they may fall, they more readily amend than before. So, if this politician had voted an immoral law into place they must publicly repudiate the act. Why, because a bad public example by a Catholic must be repudiated publicly. So, has politician “X” or any Catholic made a good confession and communion if they have not amended? Well, the answer is no.

In this way we know who is a Catholic in Good Standing by their adhering to Catholic Faith and Morals. If they are public persons, publicly acting according to Catholic Faith and Morals, they are in good standing.

**Are you a Catholic in Good Standing? May Our Lord grant us this grace for which He died that we would.**
