**Excerpts from “WHAT IS THE HOLY EUCHARIST”**

Reception of Chalice: Denial of Christ’s Real Presence and Church Authority

During the Council of Constance, which convened to end the Western Schism, the errors of John Wyclif would be condemned during Session VIII (May 4, 1415) and reconfirmed by the Bulls, Inter Cunctas and In eminentis of February 22, 1418 by Pope Martin V (1417-1431){who correctly instructs by condemning the following}:

1. In the sacrament of the altar the material substance of bread and likewise the material substance of wine remain. (Cf. DB 581)
  2. In the same sacrament the accidents of the bread do not remain without a subject. (Cf. DB 582)
  3. In the same sacrament Christ is not identically and really with His own bodily presence. (Cf. DB 583)
  4. If a bishop or priest is living in mortal sin, he does not ordain, nor consecrate, nor perform, nor baptize. (Cf. DB 584)
  5. It is not established in the Gospel that Christ arranged the Mass. (Cf. DB 585)
  6. God ought to obey the devil. (Cf. DB 586)
  7. If man is duly contrite, every exterior confession on his part is superfluous and useless. (Cf. DB 587)
  8. If the pope is foreknown and evil, and consequently a member of the devil, he does not have power over the faithful given to him by anyone, unless perchance by Caesar. (Cf. DB 588)
- {These points are all condemned. editor}*

Father Krier’s article goes on but... we conclude here. The article goes on to show how the condemned errors are alive in various churches, including the Novus Ordo practices.
