Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15)

On 1 November 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus* Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of Mary as a dogma:

By the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.

The settlers of Acadia landed in the new world August 14th 1632. Their first Mass was offered by the Capuchin Franciscans sent by Fr. Joseph Trembly OFM Cap. (His Gray Eminence). It is said that this settlement effort had already been dedicated to the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary by His Gray Eminence. The success was ascribed to Her aid and thus those Acadians (Cajuns) belong to the Blessed Virgin Mary under her title of Assumption. It is the reason for the star, a symbol of the Assumption among the Acadians. Let us honor her then by especial faithfulness on the 15th, Her feast day.
