That we may serve him without fear, in holiness and justice before him, all the days” (Luke 1:74-75)

On this day the Holy Ghost descended from on high, the paraclete: the comforter. Last week we read Our Lord’s words, “I will send you another Paraclete”, they are then both comforters, the Son and Holy Ghost. That we may receive the second we must hear the first., that we know the first we must seek the second with all his gifts.

Hearing today’s Gospel, listen to those words again: Jesus said to his disciples: If any one loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our abode with him...” Whom is it that is promised? Father and Son, we two persons. And we know that the Father is in the Son and whoever sees the Son sees the Father for they are one.

Now the Apostles Believed the Father of the Old Testament and knew the Christ so that we may clearly say they saw the Father in the Christ. Does not Christ say that he who sees Me sees the Father? Yes they believed the Son and so they knew the Father and the Son, as opposed to the imperfect and perfidious Jews who denied the Son and rejected the Father in so doing. But what are these Apostles doing cowering in the upper room? They pray. They wait in expectation. They obey prayerfully that the words of Christ would be fulfilled that they would be given another, paraclete-comforter.

Who is it that Comes this day? The Holy Spirit suddenly comes with a sound, comes and changes their carnal minds giving them love for himself; Firing their hearts inwardly while outwardly, tongues of flame burn above engulfing them. St. Gregory says: **The Holy Ghost himself is love, and so St John says: God is charity. He then, that desires God with all his mind, in truth, possesses him already whom he loves. Neither can anyone love God, if he does not possess him whom he loves.”** ☩
