Class of Gifts of the Holy Ghost known as Charismata

- Gift of speaking with wisdom
- Gift of speaking with knowledge
- Faith
- Grace of healing
- Gift of miracles
- Gift of prophecy
- Gift of discerning spirits
- Gift of tongues (i.e., xenolalia, the ability to speak foreign languages unknown by natural reason)
- Gift of interpreting speeches

Note: See I Corinthians 12:6-11; I Corinthians 12:28-31; and Romans 12:6-8. The number of items in this class of Gifts of the Holy Ghost, properly called "charismata," is disputed among theologians. Some add: Gift of government, Gift of Helps, Gift of distribution, Gift of misericordia. The charismata were/are not necessary for individual sanctification, were/are not distributed to all Christians, and are to be subjected to authority and the proper ends for which they were given (I Corinthians 12-14).

The 12 Fruits of the Holy Ghost

Charity	Benignity	Faith
Joy	Goodness	Modesty
Peace	Longanimity	Continency
Patience	Mildness	Chastity

Note: See Galatians 5:22-25 (three of these are not mentioned in some Greek and Latin manuscripts). The 12 Fruits of the Holy Ghost are the effects of the 7 Gifts of the Holy Ghost.
